Rx: Precipitated Sulfur 5% in Petrolatum

Scabies in neonates may present as small erythematous nodules, with accentuation in the axilla, trunk, and genital areas. These nodules represent a vigorous hypersensitivity response and can be mistaken for a neoplastic disorder, such as leukemia cutis. Vesicles may also form as a result of skin fragility in neonates.
